


Going from One Point to Another

Google Maps gives us direction when we don't know how to get from one destination to another. The signs on the road confirm the path that Google Maps tells us to take. "In a quarter mile turn left onto Sunshine Road." There is the sign that shows me the road Google Maps is sending me. I would have never found it without this direction.



What if we didn't have that guidance? What if the road signs disappeared? Would we be able to get from one place to another? When my husband and I first moved here we thought we would take a shortcut from the 74 By-Pass to Pea Ridge Road. The roads were marked, but we did not have electronics or Google Maps to direct us. We got lost. Sitting at an intersection trying to decide which way to go a car pulled up and asked if we needed help. We told them we were lost and where we wanted to go. They said, "Follow us and we will get you there." Without their help I think we would still be lost in the backroads of Rutherford County even after 14 years.

Let's apply this to some of the families in our area. If a child grows up in an unstable household without direction, they become adults lost on the backroads of life. How do we, who have had direction, view the one wandering the streets of life without direction? Do we stop and ask them if they need help? Do we say follow me and I will lead you? Jesus said to His disciples, "Follow me." He didn't give them the directions then say go; He took the lead and taught them along the way.



Some of those we serve have never had proper direction. There are classes they can take to teach them, but sometimes the example of someone else makes it easier to understand. The leader walking with a lost person brings encouragement and support at the fork of temptation and exhaustion. This is the support

mothers, children, and dads need. Hands of Hope provides the support for a couple of years; who takes them the rest of the time their child grows? "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their work: If one falls down, his friend can help him up. But pity the man who falls and has no one to help him up!" (Ecclesiastes 4:9, 10 NIV).

Think about the child in an undirected household. The parents of this child probably grew up in an undirected household so they don't know how to properly lead so it carries on through the generations. Strong families have strong support. Please pray and seek God's direction on how He would have you serve families in our county.


